The NWIP form

- ▶ For CENELEC 'homegrown' standards – not // EN IEC!
- ▶ To be submitted to CLC/BT when adopting a NWI (based on a TC decision)
- ▶ 4 weeks correspondence at CLC/BT
- ▶ Once the NWI is approved, CCMC registers the NWI in the TC work programme, which will appear in **Projex-Online**
- ▶ **Offering to IEC?**

Why a new NWIP form?

Through Decision D169/003, CLC/BT approved the new NWIP form to:



Integrate the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals**



Integrate **digital aspects**



Increase visibility of **environmental aspects**



Improve section on **target dates** of the Flexible standards development process



Bring **more clarity** on certain aspects



Remove outdated information



The new NWIP form
enters into force on
2022-01-10

United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs)

- ▶ In early 2021, CEN and CENELEC embarked on project to achieve the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) with a **more systematic approach to standards**
- ▶ As of November 2021, selected CEN and CENELEC TCs were invited to perform a **mapping exercise** → the result will be displayed on a the CEN-CENELEC website and on the webpages of the TCs in Spring 2022



Through a dedicated section on the new NWIP form, **each NWI will be mapped**

A CEN-CLC steering group developed a **toolkit** that provides guidance for the mapping

Changes in the NWI form

► Flexible standards development

Dates provided in the form should be correct and compliant to the rules of the [flexible development of standards](#).
