Approved in 2015 by the 193 UN members

Replacing the Millennium Goals and is our roadmap as humanity

Articulated in 5 dimensions (also known as the 5Ps): people, planet, prosperity, peace and alliances

Which, in turn, is reflected in 17 SDGs and 169 goals

## STRATEGIC CONTEXT

The strategy outlined below will not be deployed in a vacuum. Its main aim is to provide a sense of direction, to help CEN and CENELEC navigate future challenges and opportunities. This will help us to thrive in an ever-changing environment, and to better serve the evolving needs and interests of our stakeholders and customers. An incremental implementation approach, with provisions and mechanisms for regular evaluation and reprioritization, will further allow us to adapt to an often uncertain and volatile environment.

To inform our strategic direction for the decade to come, we identify below two cross-cutting, mutually reinforcing drivers of change, which we believe will reshape the socio-economic and political realities of the decades to come and change how we do business and offer value to our stakeholders and customers. We frame these drivers firmly within the overarching narrative for sustainable economic growth as stipulated in the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, while focusing on where we believe our impact and added value is greatest, which is at the European level.

## 5.2 International standardization to be a lever for sustainable development

CEN and CENELEC Members are committed to coordinating and leveraging their respective positions within ISO and IEC to drive and enhance an ambitious and consistent contribution from standardization to the United Nations' 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and 169 targets enshrined in there. Together, the ISO and IEC standards address a comprehensive array of issues across the three pillars of economic, environmental and societal sustainability. Standardization, therefore, should be recognized and used as a critical catalyst for sustainable development. CEN and CENELEC Members will coordinate and bolster the European voice at international level to further foster and materialize that strategic potential.





- Approved by CEN and CENELEC CAs in November 2022
- ► Built upon Lessons Learnt & Members' feedback
- ▶ **3 key pillars**, with strong alignment with international activities
  - Awareness-raising and capacity-building activities within the European community, exchange of best practices, peer guidance, and mutual support
  - Supporting tools for technical experts by assessing the materials developed at global level (ISO, IEC, UNECE) for possible adoption at European level
  - ▶ Review CEN and CENELEC policies and regulations for a systemic and sustained consideration of gender equality in the European standardization system, standards and standards development processes

- ► Call to Members for (re)appointment to the Informal Coordination Group on Gender Diversity & inclusivity + assessment of group's mandate

## Inclusive, open & transparent System





## → TBOs have a key role to play ←

- ▶ Be aware and make sure to include sustainability & inclusiveness aspects in the TC experts' considerations
  - Share the tools available at your disposal (e.g. Mapping of SDGs, NWIF, Guidelines, Trainings, etc.)
- ► Assume that all standards have gender implications → Gender lens ON
  - ▶ Highlight needs to consider gender-specificities and to use sex-disaggregated, etc.
- Nurture a standard-making environment that allows equal participation of all interested parties → Inclusive meetings
  - Use the tools available at your disposal: Rights and obligations of different stakeholders, Code of Conduct of experts, Guidelines on hybrid meetings, etc.
  - ► Foster enhanced participation of diverse expertise and profiles (**Representativeness**)
  - ► Ensure equal opportunities: ask for preferred timings? dietary preferences? Accessibility needs?...
- ▶ **Support** CEN and CENELEC activities on Inclusiveness & Sustainability (e.g. Project 4 Survey in Q2-2023).




