## **CENELEC webinar: 'CENELEC Submission Interface - submission of documents from TCs**

## **Questions & Answers**

1	Stage code 10:99 is 1st WD?	10.99 is the activation of the WI meaning next will be 1st WD and or ENQ.
2	When you submitted a form the status will get changed. Will it change again automatically when the next step needs to be done?	Indeed, Status will change from "Not started" to "Submitted". Once reviewed by production the status will change either to "Accepted" or "Rejected".
3	Are HAS documents also included?	Yes, in the field "comments from consultant".
4	How can documents be submitted for projects that do not yet exist, i.e. if FWD for Common Modifications for IEC based projects shall be submitted, e.g. for an early assessment? In these cases, a project number for the CM is not yet existing.	The expectation is that when the WI for common mods is needed, this is requested before the submission. This process is being clarified by BT efficiency.
5	Is it possible to inform other members of the committee for the submission (the equivalent of putting in copy during the email submission)?	SI is not a notification or email system but Assistant Secretaries under a TB can access SI and see the information available.
6	But when the uploads for Enquiry are accepted there will be a next stage, the FV. Will there be an action again together with the form for FV?	That's correct. there will be a submission for every phase of the project.
7	Is the transmission notice still necessary?	The different steps in the Submission Interface, will replace the need for the transmission notice.
8	When i go to the submission interface now, I cannot find any data. Has this to be filled out later or is it because I am not linked to my CEN/TC?	The SI version available on 2022-11-24 is not the latest version and does not include a fully correct selection.
9	Will the CEN SI be hyperlinked to <a href="https://login.cen.eu/portal/">https://login.cen.eu/portal/</a> ? And is it than integrated with the ISO Submission interface?	It is not foreseen to have a link on the CEN Portal since a link will be available on the CEN & CENELEC Expert Portal with all other applications.  There is no integration with the ISO Submission Interface. They are different applications.
