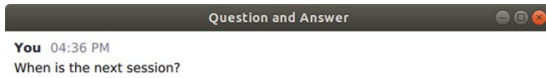

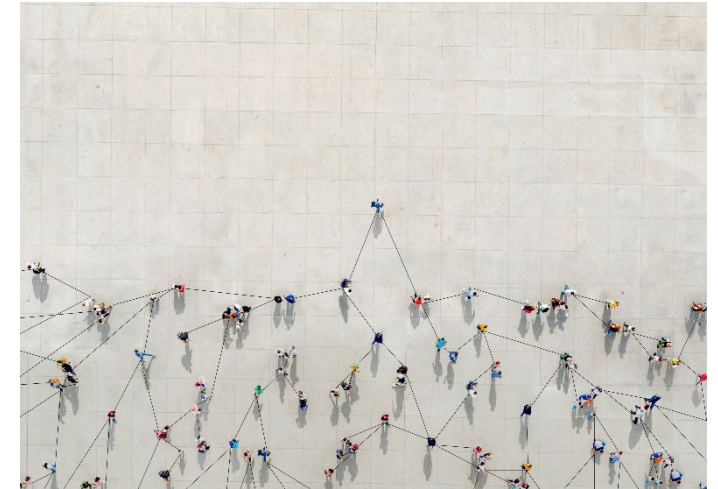

European Standardization Strategy & role of standards in Europe

- ▶ Standardization is the cornerstone of the European Single Market → reinforced by European Standardization Strategy 2022
- ▶ Clear benefits:
 1. reduction of red tape,
 2. dissemination of best practices and of innovations,
 3. same high level of quality, sustainability, safety and security
- ▶ Single Market 30th Anniversary



- ▶ Better exploit the public-private partnership and anticipate together standardization priorities
- ▶ A dimension of the EU's strategy to shape globalisation through standardization
- ▶ Establishment of the both High-Level Forum (represented by the CEN and CENELEC Presidents) and the EU Excellence Hub within the EC
- ▶ **Amendment to Regulation 1025/2012 and revision of CEN-CENELEC Internal Regulation ready for 9 July 2023**
- ▶ Focus on the Twin Transition and plan to revise standards to be green & digital
- ▶ Closer connection with other regions of the world (i.e. Africa)

Modification to Art. 10 'Standardisation requests to European standardisation Organisations' of EU Reg. 1025/2012



(2) The following paragraph is inserted:

2a. Without prejudice to other advisory opinions, each European standardization organisation shall ensure that the following **decisions concerning European standards and European standardisation deliverables** referred to in paragraph 1 are taken exclusively by **representatives of the national standardisation bodies** within the competent decision-making body of that organisation:

IT APPLIES TO ALL DECISIONS LAUNCHED AS OF 9 JULY 2023!!

(a) decisions on the acceptance and refusal of standardisation requests;

(b) decisions on the acceptance of new work items that are needed for the fulfilment of the standardisation request; and

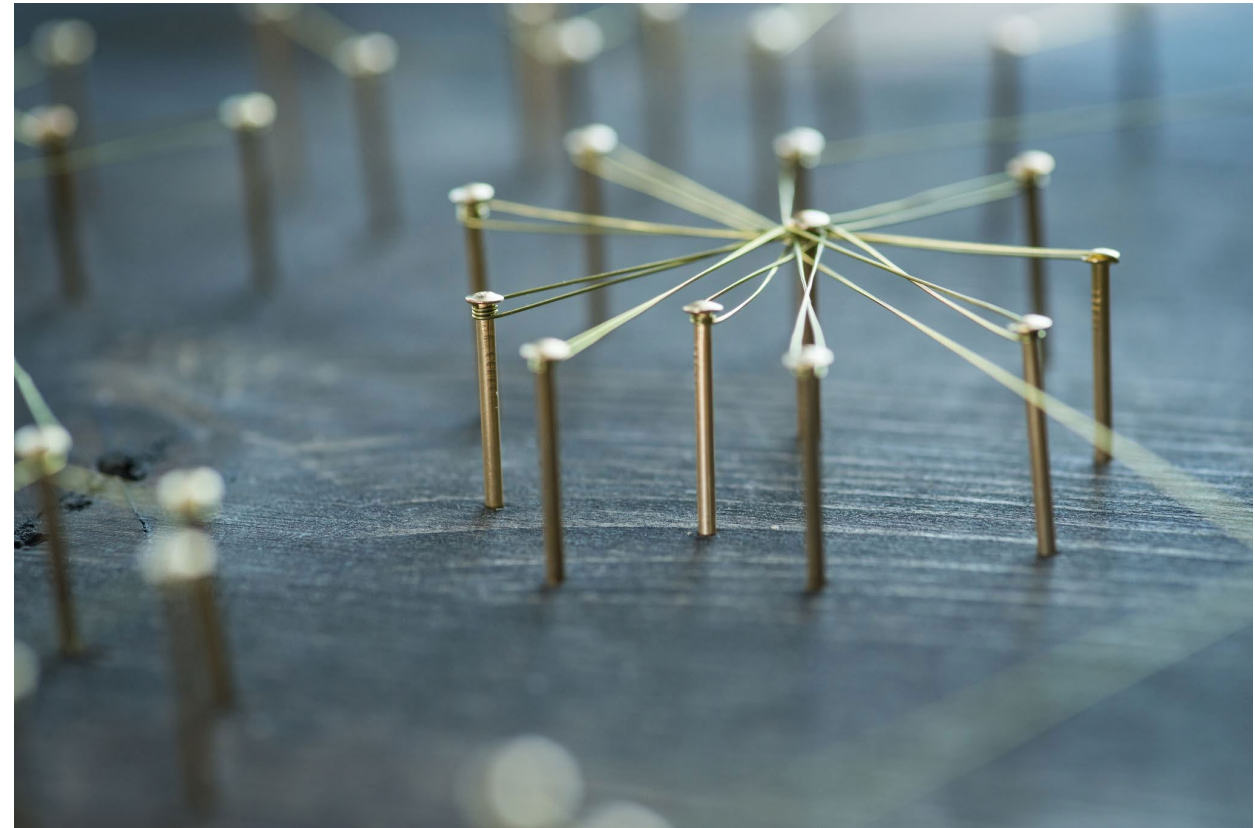
(c) decisions on the adoption, revision and withdrawal of European standards

or European standardisation deliverables.'

How we addressed the provisions of Regulation 2022/2480 (I/III)

Our compass

- ▶ Implementation of the new provisions
- ▶ Involvement of all NSBs/NCs of all type of Members in the development and decision process of standards
- ▶ Final decision: Blue-type Members



How we addressed the provisions of Regulation 2022/2480 (II/III)

Solution:

- ▶ Install a **systematic double counting of votes.**
- ▶ Always display:
 - I. outcome of the voting of all Members
 - II. the outcome of the voting of Blue-type Members
- ▶ If discrepancies: final decision taken by the Blue-type Members after discussion in the relevant BT(s)

Reflected in

- ▶ *Revised Edition of IR2:2023*
- ▶ *Additional BTs decision on operational aspects approved in May 2023*



How we addressed the provisions of Regulation 2022/2480 (III/III)

Additional BTs decision on operational aspects approved in May 2023:

- *Clarifications on what to do – operations and timing - when there is a discrepancy between the outcomes of votes with all Members Vs Blue-type only*
- *Role of Technical Board(s) to initiate European homegrown activity in case those international standards, which are included in the Standardization Requests and are expected to be developed together with ISO and IEC, are not initiated at ISO and IEC*
- *Approval of IT tools improvement to enable the double counting*

Answer: work items which are either requested in a Standardization request or developed under a Mandate.

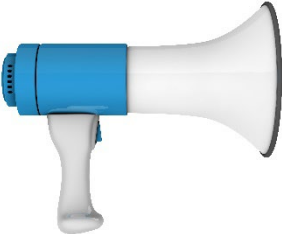


Then, as of 9 July 2023, it is CRUCIAL that:

- ▶ Mandated WIs **CORRECTLY** marked in the Database (ie. Projex-online)
- ▶ Voting policy, either 6.2 or 6.4, will depend on that

Notify CCMC directly if Projex-online link WI with legislation missing/incorrect

Responsibility of TC secretaries but can be done by anyone in technical body

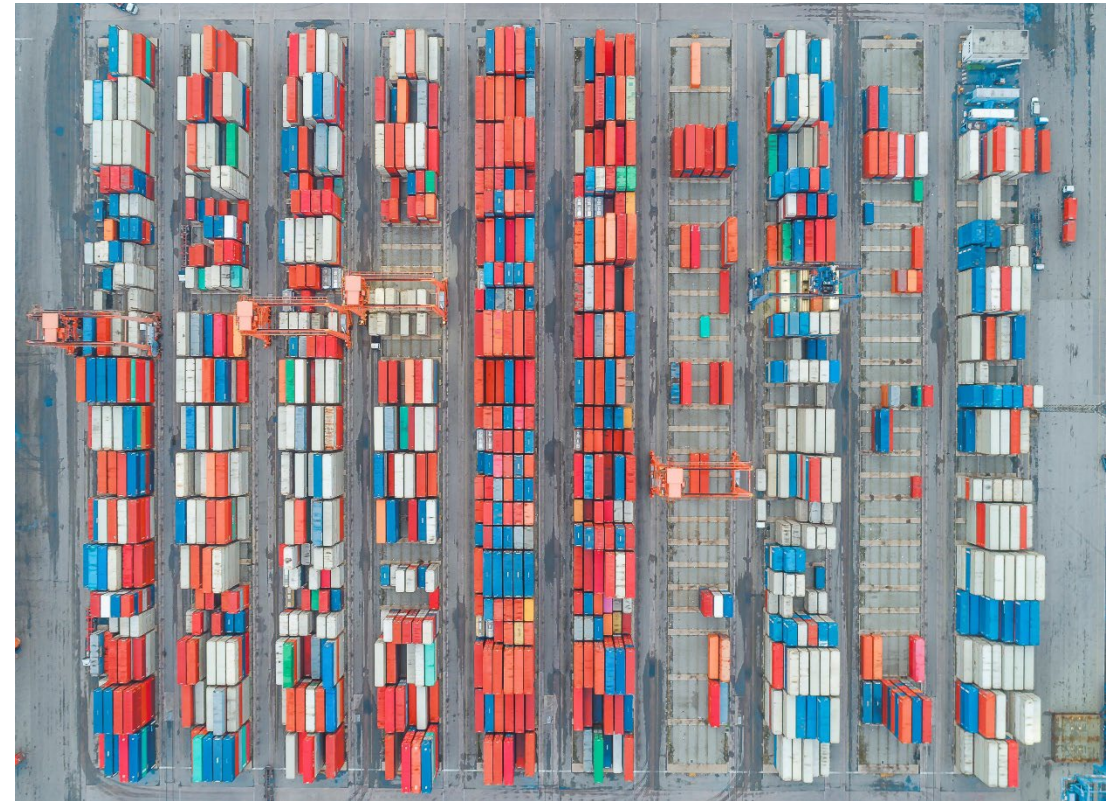

Note: if scenario 3 ('pending') happens for an EN standard, at Enquiry stage, TBs are recommended not to discuss the matter, together with all other enquiry points, at the planned TB meeting. In this case, there is no need to discuss the matter with BT and the outcomes of FV can be awaited.

Experience shows that Scenario 3 is very exceptional!

Suggestion for TBOs: **BE PREPARED** for this scenario (3). For instance, plan a meeting/call or other forms of interaction to come to an agreement on a recommendation to BT.

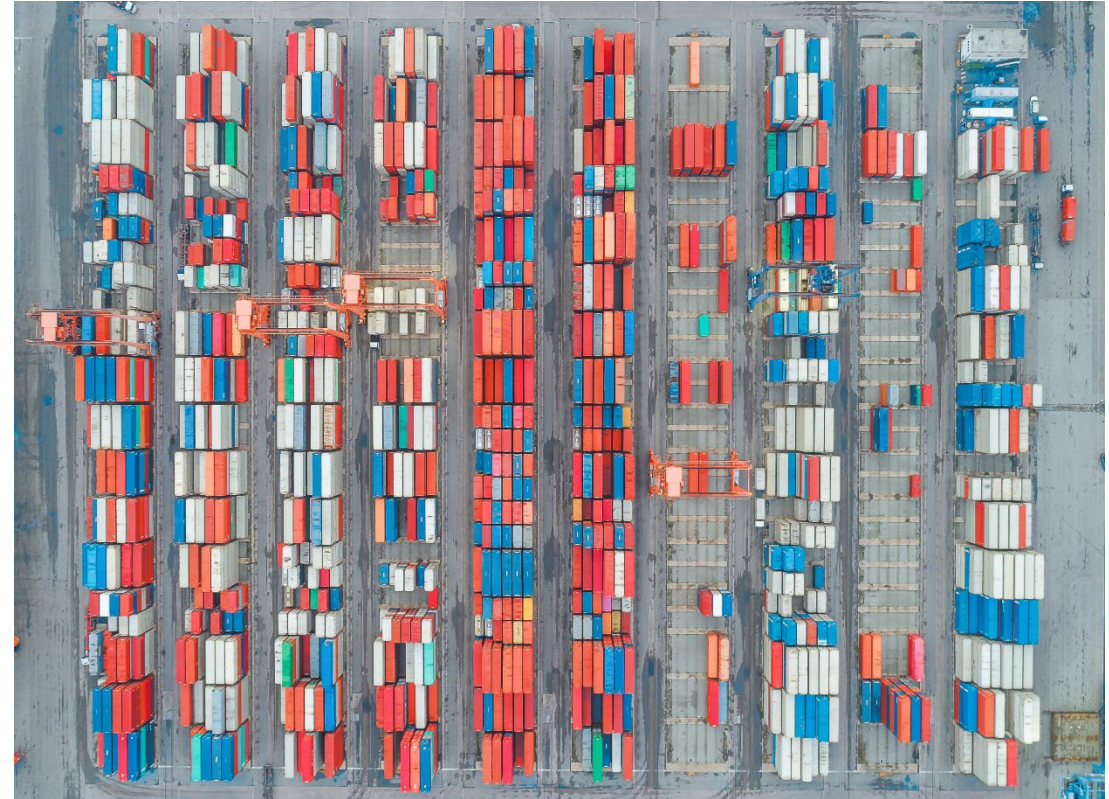

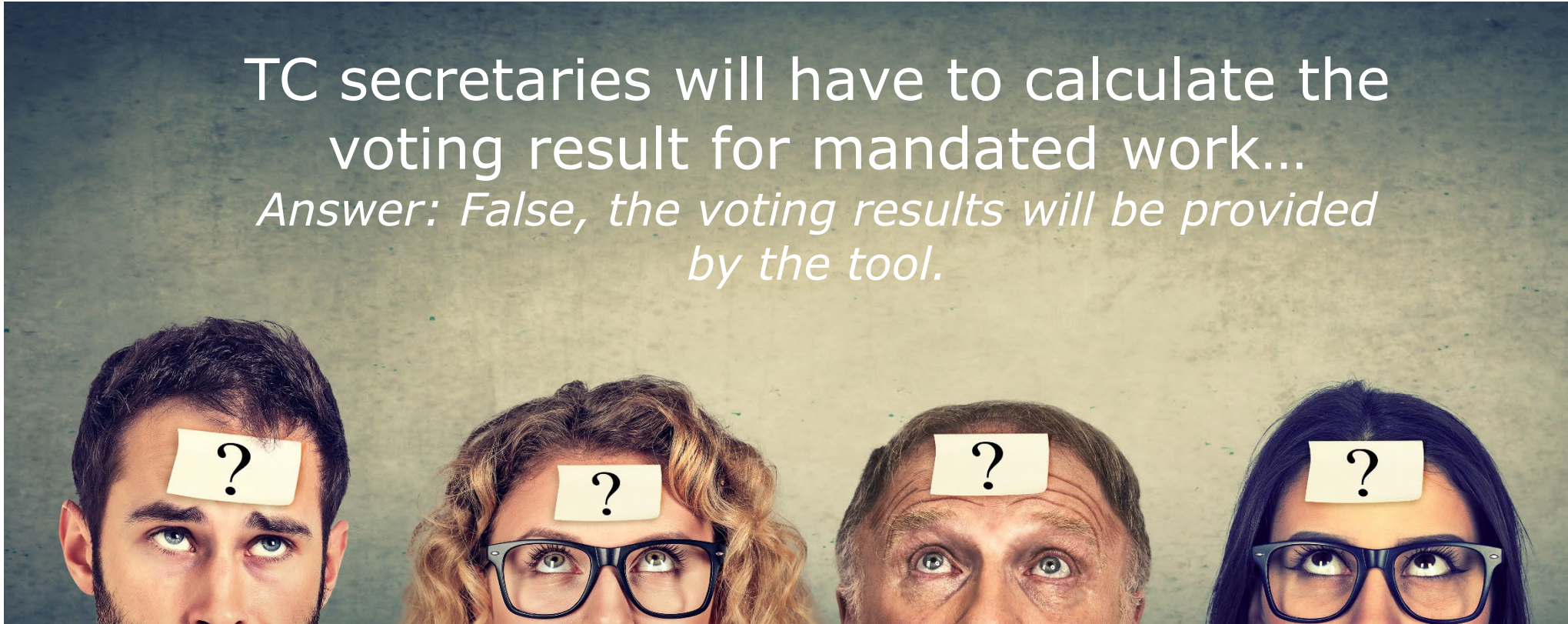

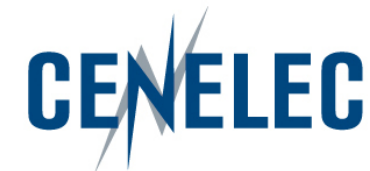
To recap

Key Take Aways

- ▶ Mandated work means that the (N)WI is requested under a Standardization Request or covered by a valid Mandate
 - > assess it before starting your work
- ▶ Crucial to ensure that Mandated (N)WIs are CORRECTLY marked as such in the Database (i.e. Projex-online)
 - > If not, inform CCMC!
- ▶ For decisions launched as of 9 July 2023, the new approval criteria for mandated work apply and may affect the approval of deliverables
 - > TC may need to provide advice in 2 weeks to BT, if outcome is 'Pending'
- ▶ No worries! No need to interpret the voting! The voting result will be in line with the relevant clause of IR2
- ▶ Nothing changes in the voting result for non-mandated work, but counting of Blue-type Members' votes will be always displayed
