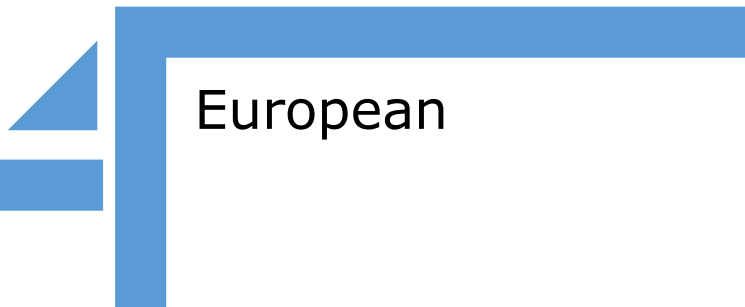

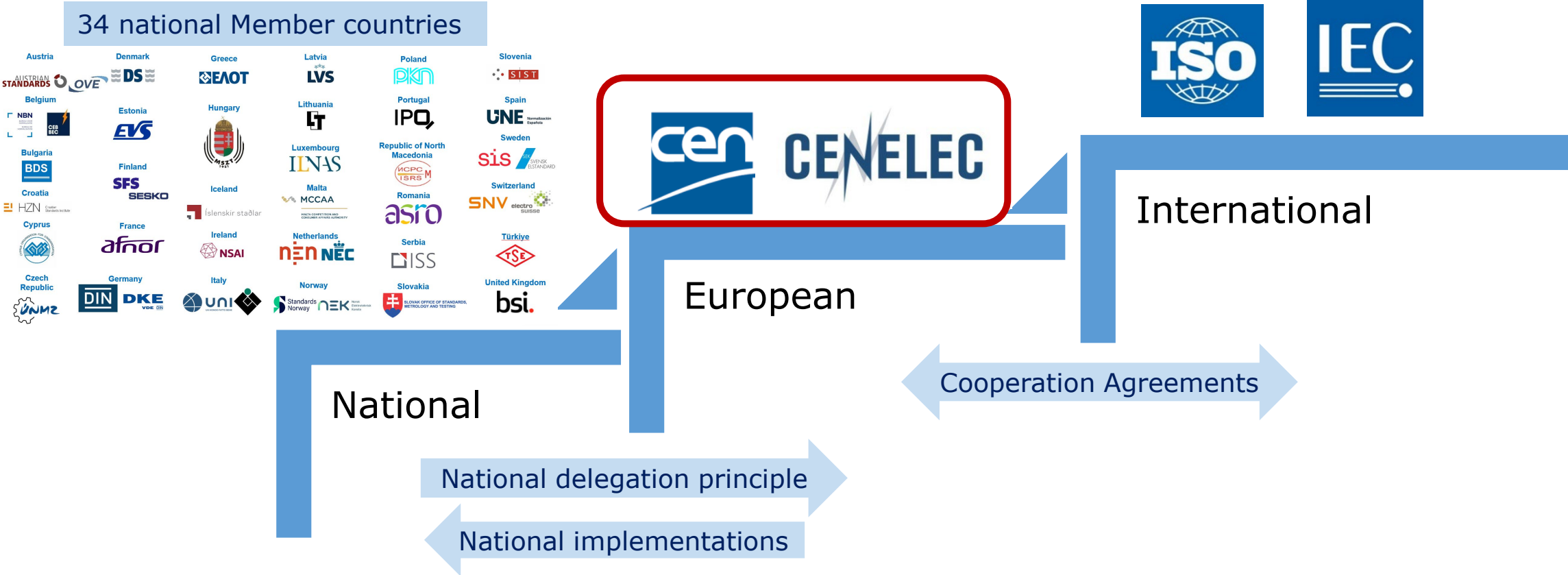

## Regulation (EU) 1025/2012 on European standardization

### Article 2

### Definitions

For the purposes of this Regulation, the following definitions shall apply:

(8) 'European standardisation organisation' means an organisation listed in Annex I;

(9) 'international standardisation body' means the International Organisation for Standardisation (ISO), the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU);

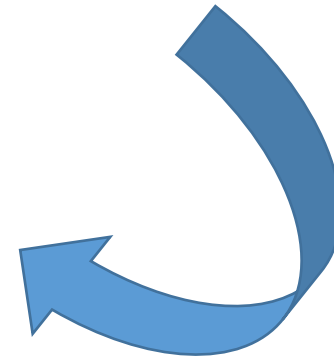

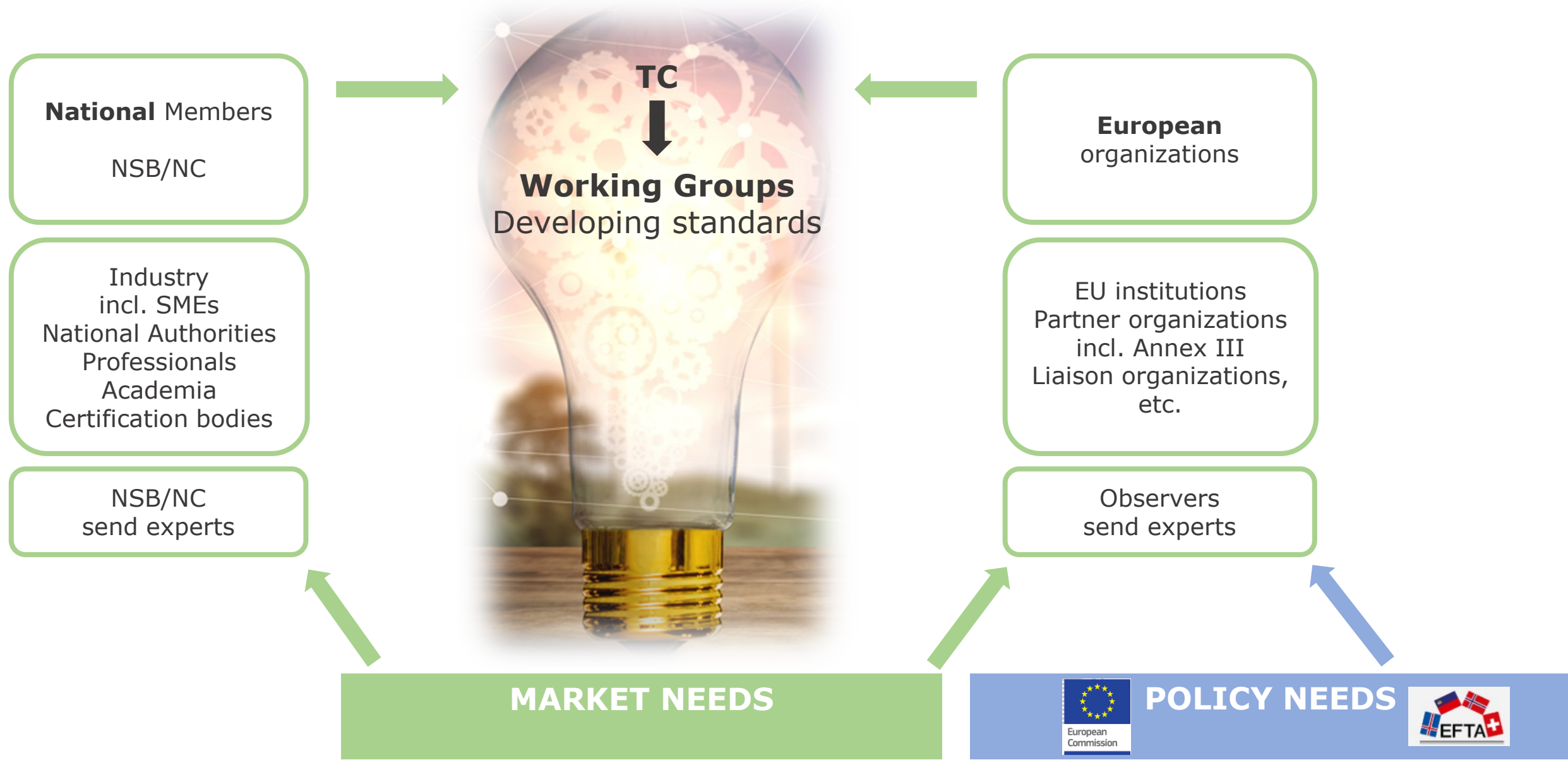

# Need beyond technical competence !



- ▶ Work for the net benefit of the European community
- ▶ Uphold key principles of international standardization:  
Consensus, transparency, openness, impartiality, effectiveness, relevance, coherence
- ▶ Agree to a clear purpose, scope, and plan to ensure timely development of deliverables
- ▶ Participate actively and manage effective representation, through official procedures in place
- ▶ Timely identify & escalate disputes through appeal mechanism
- ▶ Behave fairly and ethically – Avoid collusive, anticompetitive or dominant behaviour
- ▶ Respect others in meetings
  - Behave in a professional manner
  - Respect others and their opinions
  - Ensure that the views of all (including those whose first language is not that of the meeting) are heard and understood

Undue behaviour → Chair's intervention / Repetitive undue behaviour → Immediate info to relevant National Member's for action
