

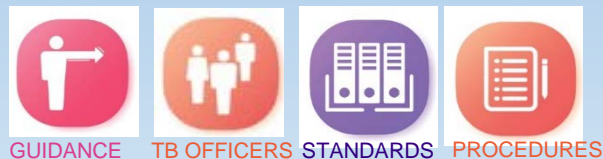

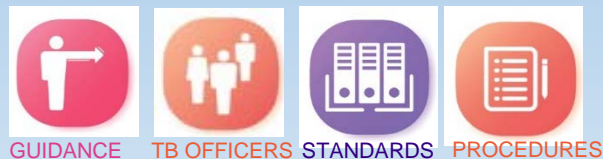

2. CENELEC Committee Internal Voting (CLC CIV)



- Similar to the CIB = CEN Committee Internal Balloting



- Login: IEC = CENELEC = some National
- Access:
 - Default: Vote Owner = TC/SC Secretaries, Assistant Secretaries, BTTF Convenors
 - National Committee (NC) admins: Voter = representatives of CENELEC National Committees
 - CCMC: Commenter = Partners, external liaison organizations, CLC Consultants

Main features

- Organize CEN or CENELEC meetings (video, audio, collaboration)
- Host meetings or schedule meetings on behalf of someone else
- Conferences with up to 500 participants
- Recording of meetings
- Screen sharing
- Use of meeting chat
- Use of parallel rooms and workspaces (breakout rooms)
- Nonverbal feedback mechanism – icons such as raise hand
- Possibility to conduct surveys

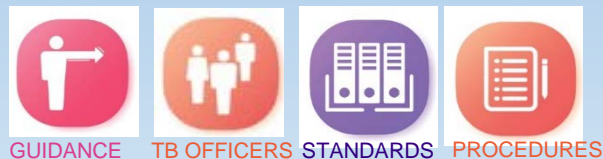

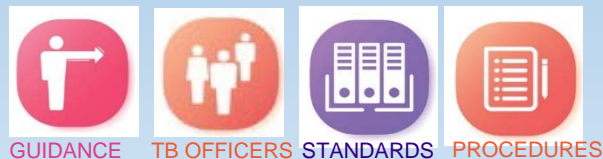

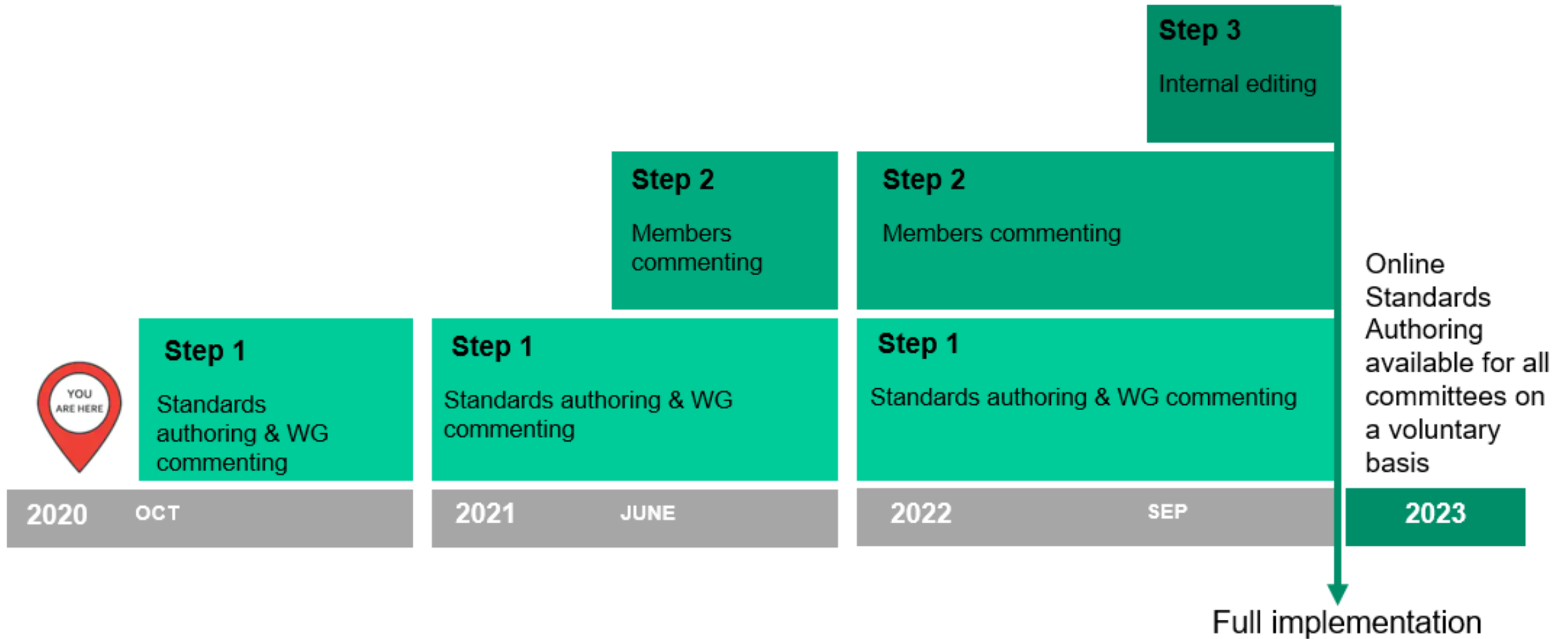
