Do you prefer paragraph break or soft-break in table header cells to place text at new line?	While there is no strict rule on soft vs hard returns in table headers, hard returns are far more practical in terms of styling content and correct layout. Soft returns can and often do lead to formatting issues, so hard returns are preferred.
According to current standardization request, standards shall not copy legal text into the standard? How to resolve this issue for harmonized standards?
